



Student Charging Structure – 2020/21 Academic Year

Dual Registered Placement

(Full time or part time placement)

Category “D”:	No Pupil Premium:	£45.00 per day
Category “E”:	With Pupil Premium:	£50.00 per day
Category “F”:	With EHC Plan	£90.00 per day (**See below)
Category “G”:	With EHC Plan and Pupil Premium:	£95.00 per day (**See below)

KS4 School Engagement Programme

(Up to 2 days per week)

Category “SEP”:	No Pupil Premium:	£22.50 per day
Category “SEPP”:	With Pupil Premium:	£25.00 per day

50% of the cost is subsidised by the Local Authority under the School Engagement Programme.

This subsidy only relates to students living in Buckinghamshire. For referral from schools outside of Buckinghamshire, rates under code “D” or “E” will apply.

KS3 12 Week Re-Engagement Programme

(Full time placement)

Category “KS3”:	No Pupil Premium:	£22.50 per day
Category “KS3P”:	With Pupil Premium:	£25.00 per day

50% of the cost is subsidised by the Local Authority for the duration of the 12 week programme.

If placement is extended after 12 weeks, Dual Registered Placement charges will apply. This subsidy only relates to students living in Buckinghamshire. For referral from schools outside of Buckinghamshire, rates under code “D” or “E” will apply.

Students with EHC Plans

Additional daily charges will apply for Students with EHC Plans or SEN Statements. Charges will vary depending on the level of SEN funding being received by the referring school from the local authority, and will be added to the basic charges as listed as above.

Example: A student with an EHC plan with allocated funding of £7,500 per year will be charged an additional daily charge which is equivalent to 1/190th of total SEN funding received by the school, and therefore in this example, the additional daily charge will £39.47, with the total charge being £84.47 per day for a category “D” student.

It is recommended that charges for placements in respect of students with EHC Plans or SEN Statements are agreed in advance at the time when the referral is being made.



Medical Needs Service (Home Tuition/Orchard House Charges) 2020/21 Academic Year

The charging structure within the overall Medical Needs Service will cover the cost of tuition provided either through the student's home, the Blueprint Home Tuition School Rooms in Aylesbury, and through Orchard House in Chesham. The Service is provided for students that are not attending their mainstream school, due to medical reasons only.

Charges for referrals for Home Tuition, Orchard House and the Blueprint Home Tuition School Rooms, are directly linked to the AWPU amount received by the school for the individual student. The weekly charge is based on 1/38th of the total AWPU received, and the weekly charge is the same, irrespective of the hours of tuition that an individual student is in receipt of.

The rates for the 2020/21 Academic Year are listed below:-

Primary:	Weekly Charge:	£ 77.34	(1/38 of £2,938.80)
KS3:	Weekly Charge:	£108.76	(1/38 of £4,133.00)
KS4:	Weekly Charge:	£123.46	(1/38 of £4,691.60)

The remaining cost of providing the service will continue to be subsidised by the Local Authority from a central budget.

Home Tuition/Orchard House Students with EHC Plans

A new charging structure was introduced from September 2017, where the referring school will be charged the full Home Tutor cost at a rate of £40 per hour. This is to ensure that the additional SEN funding paid to the referring school is being used directly to support the individual needs of the student for the duration whilst the student is registered with the Home Tuition Service, Orchard House and Blueprint Home Tuition School Rooms.

The total weekly charge will be based on the number of hours of tuition provided, and can vary from week to week. However, the maximum weekly charge will be capped at 1/38th of the total AWPU and the total SEN funding received by the referring school.

Example: A KS3 student receiving SEN funding of £6,507 per year, and AWPU of £4,133, will be charged no more than £280 per week. (£6,507 plus £4,133 = £10,640 divided by 38 weeks). In this example, if the level of the tuition required is greater than amount of funding available, agreement with the SEN Team to provide additional funding will need to be in place at the time of the referral.

It is recommended that charges for student referrals with EHC Plans are agreed in advance at the time when the referral is being made.

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
