Pupil Premium/Non Pupil Premium

The results for these students with regards to the number of qualifications attained were broadly comparable.

There is a gap in results in the overall English results with those in receipt of the premium being slightly stronger with 23/47 of 92% attaining the qualification which is pleasing. However the percentage of those in receipt of the premium who achieved a grade of 9-4 was lower (4%) in comparison to 10.8% of those not in receipt of the grant. It is worth considering why this might be the case and how we could support these students during the current academic year. Do they simply need encouragement? Or do they require intervention? It would be worth questioning this with the results in Maths in mind, as 16% those in receipt of the premium achieved a grade 9-4, compared to 4% in English.

SEND/Non SEND

Almost across the board the results of those students with a defined SEND were greater than those without. This is a fantastic reflection of the work of colleagues in supporting our students, it clearly shows that when we are able to teach in groups with the student teacher ratios that we have that those with an SEND attain in line if not better than other students. For many it might also reflect and help underline the reasons why they end up at Aspire, mainstream schools do not have the luxury of the class sizes that we do and so a student who is struggling may become a challenge in the classroom. Finally, this is also a positive reflection of the ongoing whole school CPD programme offered to staff to support their understanding of our student's needs.

Male/Female

Again results across the board are broadly in line with one another. However, it's interesting to note the difference in those attaining a 9-4 in English 6.4% and those attaining a 9-4 in Maths 12.8%. Again, for the benefit of current students it would be interesting and worthwhile to consider why this might be the case and what can we learn to support the students to attain these higher grades.

Sites

We have felt that The Wycombe Grange works well as a site for Key Stage 4 students for some time and this summer's results back this up. It is important to question what is it exactly that is working and how can this be reflected in our other sites so that we are being equitable. This is a question that we will come back to this year.

Year 10 Students

There is a total of 12 year 10 students who entered qualifications and 10 achieved at least one qualification.
